

What do you need to project the Mass?

#### Projectors – Laser vs Bulb?

- Laser
  - No filter
  - Quick (safe) startup and shutdown
  - Visibility
    - Brightness and color
- Based on YOUR space and natural light

#### Screens

- Fixed Vs. Retractable
  - Aesthetics
  - o Longevity?
- Size
  - Relative to your available space
  - o Go BIG!
- Electrical?

#### Content Management Device

- Mac or PC
  - O PowerPoint? ProPresenter?
- Location
  - o Know your space
  - O Best view

  - o Teens?




What do the people need to see?

  - Words Longer, less flexibility

#### Spoken Responses / Instructions

- Great for the "Unchurched"
- Weddings / Funerals
- Mass with a bishop
- Instructions Ex:
  - Low-gluten hosts

- Those needing a <u>low-gluten</u> host should come to the <u>priest's line</u> during distribution and indicate one is needed.
- Receiving from the chalice is not <u>required</u> to receive the full grace of the Sacrament.
- Self-intinction (dipping the Host in the chalice) is not permitted.

  - Maintain attention and focus




